TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1, Feb 5: NEW YORK

Board Egypt Air flight direct from JFK to Cairo.

DAY 2, Feb 6: CAIRO

Arrival at Cairo airport. After you clear customs and collect your luggage, our representative will meet you and assist with the transfer to your hotel. Dinner in the hotel. (D)

DAY 3, Feb 7: CAIRO

This morning we drive to the Giza Plateau, home of Egypt's signature attractions: the Great Pyramids, proclaimed by the Greeks to be among the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. [We visit the great Pyramids of Giza and their guardian Sphinx, Memphis- first capital of the ancient kingdom to see the statue of Ramses II then to Sakkara to see the Step pyramid.](#) (B,L,D)

DAY 4, Feb 8: CAIRO

Today you will begin with a tour of the National Egyptian Museum which houses Ancient Egypt's most precious artifacts and remains. Enjoy a memorable tour through Africa's largest bazaar, Khan el Khalili with lunch in a local restaurant. After a few hours here head for a monument that beckons Egypt's Islamic past in the modern streets of this cosmopolitan city. The Citadel, dedicated to the ruler who chased Napoleon and his troops out of Egypt in 1801, Sultan Hassan Mosque, which all represent the artistic and architectural grandeur of Medieval Egypt. Evening overnight train to Aswan. (B,L,D)

DAY 5, Feb 9: ASWAN

Transfer from train to the hotel. Free morning to enjoy the scenic views of Aswan. Afternoon camel excursion to St. Simeon's monastery in the sands of the Sahara on the West Bank for a Releasing Technique Workshop lead by Psychic Dave. Overnight in hotel. (B,D)

DAY 6, Feb 10: CRUISE

Morning optional excursion to Abu Simbel. [Then we will be escorted to embark on the Nile cruise ship-our floating hotel for the next five days. After lunch, we sail by 'felucca' a traditional Nile sailing boat, to view Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Overnight in Aswan.](#) (B,L,D)

DAY 7, Feb 11: CRUISE

[Today we visit the impressive Aswan High Dam and its huge lake, and the Temple of Philae. Then we cruise to Kom Ombo to visit the Temple shared by the Gods Sobek & Haroeris. Tonight we enjoy a special costume party featuring Native Egyptian and pharaonic style.](#) (B,L,D)

DAY 8, Feb 12: CRUISE

[This morning we explore the Temple of Horus, the falcon god.](#) Afternoon to soak up the atmosphere and culture of life on the Nile as we sail to Luxor. [Overnight in Luxor.](#) (B,L,D)

DAY 9, Feb 13: CRUISE

[Today we explore](#) the Necropolis of Thebes, [the wondrous Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut's Temple, and the Colossi of Memnon.](#) In the evening, [we visit](#) the [Karnak and Luxor Temple. Overnight in Luxor.](#) (B,L,D)

DAY 10, Feb 14: LUXOR

Breakfast on boat before disembarking. Free day to explore the city of Luxor with a Past Life Regression workshop lead by Psychic Dave in Luxor Temple on the East Bank. Overnight in Hotel. (B,D)

DAY 11, Feb 15: ALEXANDRIA

Early morning flight to Cairo. Day tour to Alexandria, Egypt's second largest city and main port, which was founded by Alexander the Great in 331 BC. Explore the well-preserved ruins of the Roman amphitheater, Roman catacombs, and Alexandria Library. Afternoon to see the Fort of Qaitbey from the outside. Overnight in Cairo near the airport. (B,L,D)

DAY 12, Feb 16: CAIRO

Transfer to the airport for onward flight to JFK. (B)
